



BFF Program Eligibility: January 2019

- 1) Students in kindergarten through 12th grade, with priority given to 3rd, 8th and 9th grades.
- 2) Students with an open DCF case, living in Out-of-Home Placement:
 - a) Foster Home
 - b) Group Home
 - c) Relative (Not with mother or father)
 - d) Non-Relative
- 3) Students must be attending a traditional, public school. No charter or alternative schools.
- 4) Because need exceeds capacity within our caseloads, eligibility does not guarantee enrollment.
- 5) Priority enrollment will be given to the following schools:
